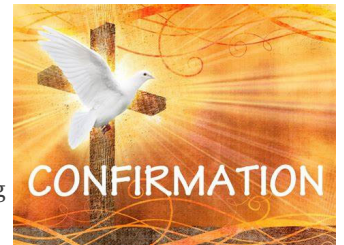

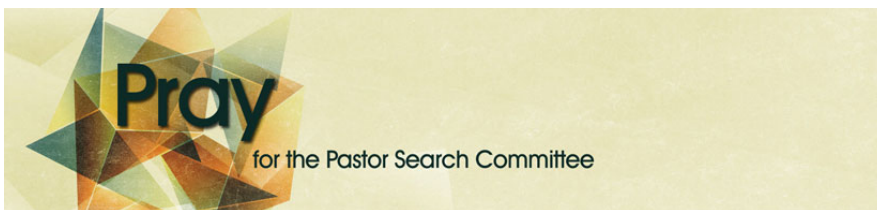
Online Confirmation This Sunday at 5:30 pm
